The MOCILyC was founded in 1995 by a group of educators, artists, musicians, composers, and researchers with a common interest: children's music and song. For the first time since 1995, The Event returns to the Antillean Caribbean with the Puerto Rico Conservatory of Music as the main venue. It is our desire to reunite not only those interested from Latin America, but also artists, teachers, musicians, and researchers who work with Latin American and Caribbean children in the diaspora.

During these seven days, you will have the opportunity to participate in workshops, lectures, conferences, and musical presentations by artists, educators, and people interested in the genre of children's music.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS for SELECTED ARTISTIC AND/OR ACADEMIC PARTICIPANTS:

Non-resident foreigners will be provided with:

- Transportation to and from the "Luis Muñoz Marín" International Airport to the place of lodging from October 6 to 13, 2022.
- Transportation to the venues, sound equipment, infrastructure, and adequate facilities for their presentation.
- Various activities (MOCILyC General Assembly, cultural tours, among others).
- Selected artists and exhibitors **WILL NOT PAY** registration to the meeting.

Subject to availability of funds:

- Food (breakfast, lunch, and dinner) between the afternoon of Thursday, October 6 and the morning of Thursday, October 13 (and at least, the days they have presentations).
